

Please Note:

When using a USB connection with an external device, if the required current is too high, the external device may need its own power supply (e.g., an external hard drive or portable optical drive).

To transmit a digital signal to another audio device, use a standard COAX cable (do not use an AV cable). We recommend using an RG6/U shielded cable with gold-plated connectors.



- 1. Power: Connect the power cable to an AC outlet rated at 100 240V ~ 50/60 Hz.
- 2. SPDIF input: Digital audio output.
- 3. L/R AV1 IN: Connect the Left and Right Audio output of DVD or VCR (with AV/Y Pb Pr input).
- 4. Earphone: Connect the headphone.
- 5. Antenna Input: Connect external antenna to receive the ATV/DVB-T2 program in ATV/DVB-T2 mode.
- 6. RJ45: Connect external modem or network access equipment.
- 7. HDMI Input: Connect the HDMI source.
- 8. USB: Connecting for USB device.
- 9. HDMI Input: Connect the HDMI source.

PREPARATION OF REMOTE CONTROL

Place the remote control on an even surface and insert the supplied batteries into the remote control as follows, Under normal use the battery will last for six months. Take out battery when the remote is not in use for a long time

 Softly push the back cover to open the battery compartment.



Insert two batteries(1.5V size AAA), please make sure the polarity matches the marks inside the compartment.




3. Softly press the back cover to close it.



OPERATION OF REMOTE CONTROL

Point the remote control unit from on more than about 7m from the remote control sensor and within about 60 degrees of the front of the unit.



NOTE:

- The operating distance may vary depending to the brightness around.
- Do not point bright lights directly at the remotecontrol sensor.
- Do not place objects between the remote-control unit and the remote-control sensor.
- Do not use this remote-control unit while simultaneously operating the remote-control unit of any other equipment.

4. System Connections

Do not connect the power cord until all other connections have been made. Ensure that you observe the color cord when connecting audio and video cables.

4.1 CONNECTING TO POWER SUPPLY


- · Connect the power cord correctly to the power outlet.
- Press the POWER switch of your TV to switch ON. The power indicator on the front panel lights up in Green.

4.2 CONNECTION TO EXTERNAL AV SIGNAL SOURCE

Use the audio and video cable to connect the input jacks on the rear panel of the unit to the external AV signal source.

Connect the unit and the external AV signal source to the respective jacks with the S-Video cable

Ensure that you observe the color cord when connecting audio and video cables.



After connection, turn on the power of the unit and the external AV signal source. Press SOURCE then direction buttons to select AV mode, and then press the ENTER button to confirm

NOTE:

· The L/R Audio input jacks can be used in the both composite modes.

4.3 CONNECTING TO EXTERNAL NETWORK SOURCE (RJ45)

The RJ45 input jack(Ethernet jack) on the rear panel of the device allows for wired network connectivity. Use a standard Cat5e/Cat6 cable to link theRJ45 port on the unit to your router, modem, or switch.

Avoid bending the cable sharply to prevent signal degradation.

4.4 CONNECTING TO EXTERNAL HDMI SIGNAL SOURCE

Follow the figure below to connect an HDMI signal source to the HDMI jack on the rear panel of the unit



After connection, turn on the power of the unit and the external AV signal source and use the SOURCE and the DIRECTION buttons to select HDMI mode, and then press the ENTER button to confirm.

HDMI provides both audio and video signals and typically provides superior image quality to component or composite.

4.5 CONNECTING TO DIGITAL AUDIO (SPDIF)

The SPDIF port on the rear panel of the unit enables high-quality digital audio transmission. Use an optical or coaxial cable to link the SPDIF OUT port on your audio source (e.g., Blu-ray player, game console) to the SPDIF IN port on the unit.



After connection, Access the unit's audio menu and select "SPDIF" or "Digital Audio In" as the input source. Choose the appropriate format (e.g., PCM, Dolby Digital, DTS) based on your source device's capabilities.

4.6 CONNECTING TO TV SIGNAL INPUT

Connect the TV signal cable (the antenna cable, for example) to the antenna input jack on the back of the unit so that you can receive television programmers.



4.6 CONNECTING TO DIGITAL AUDIO (EARPHONE)

Insert the plug of your earphones firmly into the jack until it clicks into place. Ensure the plug is fully inserted for optimal audio quality.



After connection, adjust volume using either: The unit's volume button or Your earphone's inline controls (if available)

4.6 CONNECTING TO EXTERNAL HARD DRIVE (USB)

Insert your USB flash drive or external hard drive directly into the port. For USB cables, ensure the standard Type-A connector is properly aligned before insertin.



The TV will automatically detect compatible media files. Navigate to the "Media" or "USB" input source using your remote control.







8. Troubleshooting

Carry out the problem–solving measures described in the following section before contacting customer support. Turn off the device immediately as soon as you suspect a malfunction and unplug the power plug. Do not attempt to repair the device yourself.
